Once a course has been completed, find the link in the course information to request CE's. A CE request must be done within 3 days of course completion. Please note that some states require processing within 10 days, and if you do not comply with this requirement, you may be charged a late fee. CEU Institute will process the credit and send your certificate, generally within 7 – 10 business days.

***Special Instructions for Florida:** Florida requires students to agreement to the Affidavit of Personal Responsibility. "I affirm, under penalty of perjury, that I personally completed the entire text of the self-study course. I also affirm, under penalty of perjury, that I completed the exam without assistance from any source. I understand that it is my responsibility to file or maintain my Certificate of Completion as required by any Department of Financial Services (DFS)."

****Special Instructions for Louisiana:** Louisiana requires a student to remain in the course for an amount of time that equals the number of CEs. For example, to get one CE hour the student must remain in the course material 50 minutes, for two CE hours – 100 minutes, etc. To facilitate this, a 'timer' has been added to the course pages and the student homepage that shows the elapsed amount of time in the course. If a student takes the exam before the minimum amount of time has elapsed, CEs cannot be processed for that course in Louisiana. CE credit is being administered by CEU Institute.

***** Special Instructions for Texas:** Licensees may only take up to 50% of their required CE as a self-study course.
